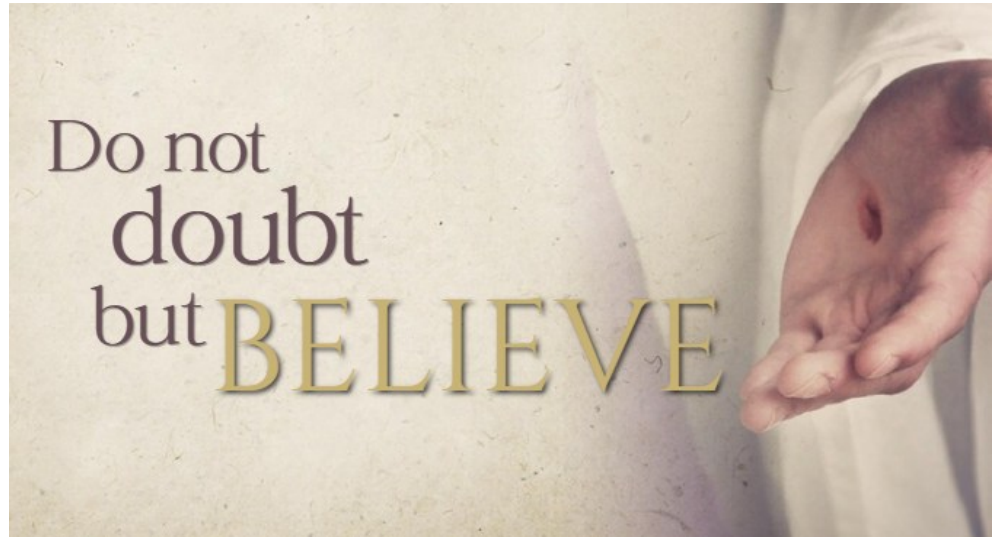

## Second Sunday of Easter



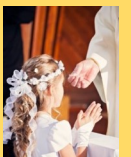

The readings tell us about faith, hope, and the joy that comes from meeting the risen Jesus. They also remind us that believing in Him brings new life. The Gospel tells the story of Thomas. At first, he doubted the other disciples. When he saw Jesus, he believed. Jesus said that those who believe without seeing are blessed. We are invited to trust Him even when we do not have all the answers.

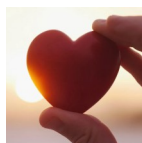

## Dear Parishioners

The OLS Finance Council presents the attached Annual Financial Report for 2025.  
We invite you to take some time to review this report.

### **Thank you for your generous donations to our parish home in 2025.**

Your ongoing commitment—through weekly offertory, special collections, and increased giving during a time of inflation and uncertainty—reflects the deep and generous spirit of our community. Your support helps us live our parish vision: to be an ever-growing beacon of God’s love, hope, and joy for all.

A particular highlight this year was our parish’s record-breaking ShareLife total of \$556,253. At a time when many in our local community are facing food insecurity and financial hardship, your generosity is a powerful witness to our Gospel call to serve those most in need.

### **Financial Overview**

2025 was a stable year from a financial perspective, with receipts of \$1.86 million (including \$372,000 in special collections not retained by the parish) and a modest surplus of \$36,000. This reflects careful stewardship and the strong, steady support of our parish community.

Offertory giving remained strong, and rental income, program revenue, and the net proceeds from the expanded Parish Fundraising Dinner helped reduce pressure on offertory alone. We also completed important safety upgrades, accessibility improvements, and required maintenance work, as outlined in last fall’s Building Committee Report.

Donations made in 2025 to help fund specific capital projects positioned the Parish well as we enter a year of major infrastructure renewal.

### **How Your Donations Support the Parish**

**1. Programming:** Your support allows us to offer high-quality, high-impact programming that strengthens our faith life. While not every sacramental preparation program grew in numbers this year, participation across many ministries remains strong. Our expanded music programs continue to enrich our worship and deepen our communal prayer. We manage operating costs carefully while ensuring programs remain vibrant and accessible.

**2. Maintenance:** Caring for our beautiful but aging church requires ongoing attention. Your generosity allows us to take a proactive approach to repairs, prevention, and security—addressing issues before they become more serious and costly.

### **Major Capital Project: New Heating and Cooling System**

In 2025, the Building Committee, on behalf of the parish, commissioned an evaluation of the Church’s building systems that was performed by an engineering consultant. As a result, the Finance Council and Building Committee are now moving forward with replacing our nearly 30-year-old heating, ventilation and air-conditioning system (HVAC).

Thanks to parishioner contributions to the previous Family of Faith Campaign and more recent gifts designated for HVAC replacement, we began this project with \$565,000 already set aside. Continued parish support has brought us to \$816,000 as of March 25, 2026.

As detailed plans were put in place to undertake the HVAC replacement project, the Building Committee determined that repairing and insulating the church attic should be completed at the same time. Improving the insulation layer and strengthening the building envelope while installing new HVAC equipment is both cost-effective and responsible stewardship.

With this added work, the revised total project cost is estimated at \$1,120,000. We therefore aim to raise \$300,000 to fully fund the project. All donations continue to be matched up to \$125,000, thanks to a generous parishioner.

### **Building Items Being Monitored for 2026**

In addition to the HVAC project, the Building Committee continues to monitor several areas of the church and rectory. These items are not planned 2026 projects, but items requiring attention over time:

- the condition of the stained-glass windows
- marble walls and panels near radiators
- the aging flat roof on the south side of the rectory
- the church sound system, which is being replaced in phases, beginning this spring with new soundboards

Your monthly contributions to the OLS Building and Maintenance Fund are essential in helping us care for our parish home. We are committed to being good stewards of your donations to help keep our aging parish home in good repair, so that OLS can continue to be a place where our spiritual lives can thrive.

### **Parish Life**

Beyond financial results, your generosity directly supports the sacramental and spiritual life of our community. Participation in parish ministries continues to flourish. The Liturgy of the Word with Children now runs at both the 9:30 am and 12:30 pm Masses. Mass attendance has grown to 1,245 each weekend, an 8% increase from 2024—an encouraging sign of deepening engagement.

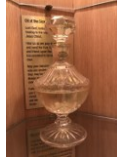
