

Palm Sunday



The readings for Palm Sunday focus on the sacrifice which Jesus Christ made for us. As we contemplate the suffering and death of Jesus, we are struck by the paradox of His divinity and His willingness to endure such great pain and humiliation.

He turned to prayer, even in His darkest hour in the garden of Gethsemane and entrusted all into the loving care of His Father. He remained obedient, even when His closest friends betrayed Him and abandoned Him. As followers of Jesus, we are also called to trust in God completely. In the face of trials and difficulties, we can turn to prayer and trust God's loving care.

Reflection Questions:

- How do I respond when facing suffering or adversity in my life?
- Do I turn to prayer and rely on God's strength and comfort, or try to handle things on my own?
- How can I deepen my relationship with God?

Good Friday A day of fasting and abstinence from meat

Fasting takes on its deepest meaning when it opens our hearts to prayer, unites us with those who suffer from hunger, and helps us redirect our resources to support the poor.

According to Church law:

- Abstinence from meat is required of all Catholics aged 14 and older
- Fasting is required of those aged 18 to 59

Parents and educators are encouraged to gradually introduce children to the spirit and practice of penance. The example set by adults is the most powerful teacher in fostering this understanding.

Phone Ministry for Homebound Parishioners

Volunteers will offer companionship and encouragement through phone calls, ensuring that no parishioner feels forgotten.
