Mercy and Faith

The readings for the 2nd Sunday of Easter help us reflect on the unlimited mercy of God. In today's Gospel, Jesus shows mercy to Thomas, even in his doubts.

After the crucifixion of Jesus, the disciples were afraid that they would be arrested and put to death, just like their leader. But then, Jesus appears to them and says, "Peace be with you." Jesus forgives his disciples for abandoning him during his crucifixion. He does not hold their fear or doubt against them. Instead, he offers them peace and forgiveness.

When Jesus appears to Thomas, he tells him "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed." Like Thomas, we may struggle with doubt and uncertainty -- but through faith and trust in Jesus, we can experience the peace and joy that comes from knowing the risen Christ.

Reflection Questions:

- How can I overcome my own doubts about my faith and deepen my trust in God's mercy?
- What can I do to support and encourage others who are struggling in their faith?
- How can I extend God's mercy to others in my life? Is there someone in my life I need to forgive or show compassion to?
