

Passion Sunday

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week and the readings invite us to reflect on the depth of Jesus' sacrifice and the meaning of his triumphal entry into Jerusalem.

We see Jesus as a humble and peaceful king surrounded by crowds of people who wave palm branches and shout his praises. This image reminds us of Jesus' identity as a powerful and beloved leader who comes to save us from sin and death.

At the same time, we are also reminded of the cost of Jesus' sacrifice. The Gospel reading describes the events leading up to Jesus' crucifixion. We see Jesus' selflessness and obedience, even in the face of intense suffering and humiliation.

The readings on Palm Sunday ask us to place ourselves in the events of Holy Week and consider how we would have responded had we been there: perhaps we would have been among the crowd on the street singing Hosanna, or maybe one of the people complaining about demonstrators disrupting our preparations for the Passover. We might have been sitting next to Peter, denying we even know the Lord, fearful and afraid. Or among the crowd calling for the crucifixion of Jesus.

We are invited to consider our own personal response to Jesus' sacrifice. Are we willing to follow his example of love, humility, and selflessness?



Palm Sunday

Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week.
The day recalls Jesus' triumphal entry into the city of our salvation that takes place about a week before his Resurrection (Easter).

Why do we wave palms?

When Jesus rode into Jerusalem, crowds greeted him by waving palms and covering his path with small branches. We wave palms today to hail Christ in his triumph for our salvation in the light of his Paschal Mystery - his Passion, Death and Resurrection.

Jesus enters Jerusalem. The crowd of disciples accompanies him in festive mood, their garments are stretched out before him, there is talk of the miracles he has accomplished, and loud praises are heard:

Abstinence and Fasting are to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting is the limitation of food and drink – typically to one main meal and two smaller meals, with no solid foods in between.

Catholics age 14 + are obliged to practice abstinence.
Catholics 18-59 are obliged to fast.

On Fridays, we abstain from eating meat since Jesus sacrificed his flesh for us on Good Friday. Those outside the age limits and those whose state in life (pregnant women, those who are ill) may be excused from the requirements of fasting and abstinence but encouraged to take up some other form of penitence or act of charity or piety on this day.

Children at the 9:30am Mass are to remain with their families since there will be no Children's Liturgy of the Word.

Special Collection on Good Friday, April 7 - This annual collection supports the work of the Franciscan Custody of the Holy Land in preserving the Sacred Places, promoting the Christian presence in the Holy Land and providing aid to the poor. Special envelopes are available at the church entrance.

PASCHAL: associated with the Hebrew Passover; referring to Jesus as the Lamb of God TRIDUUM: derived from the Latin for three days

The Paschal mystery has two aspects: by his death, Christ liberates us from sin; by his Resurrection, he opens for us the way to a new life.

The Paschal Triduum bridges the seasons of **Lent** to **Easter**.

In the Sacred Triduum, the Church solemnly celebrates the greatest mysteries of our redemption, keeping by means of special celebrations the memorial of her Lord, crucified, buried, and risen.

HOLY THURSDAY:

"Jesus gives himself to us as food and, in the washing of feet, teaches us the need to serve others."

GOOD FRIDAY:

"In the mystery of Christ's death on the cross, we contemplate that undying divine love which embraces all mankind and summons us in turn to love one another in the power of the Spirit."

HOLY SATURDAY:

"The day of God's silence - invites us not only to solidarity with all who are abandoned and alone, but also to trust in that faithful love which turns death into life."
