

Fifth Sunday of Easter



This Sunday, the Gospel presents us with the beautiful metaphor of the vine and the branches. Jesus emphasizes the importance of remaining in Him to bear fruit. Like branches that cannot survive, let alone bear fruit when severed from the vine, our spiritual lives wither without a deep and sustaining connection to Christ.

Bearing fruit requires trust and drawing strength from God. It involves pruning - letting go of what hinders our growth and embracing a process of spiritual refinement. This is not always comfortable, but it's necessary for growth. We are reminded that our efforts, grounded in faith and sustained by grace, can lead to abundant life for ourselves and others.

Reflection Questions:

- Reflecting on the metaphor of the vine and the branches, how connected do I feel to Christ in my daily life?
- What practices can I strengthen to help me grow closer to Jesus?
- What "pruning" do I need to undergo to bear more fruit?

Perinatal Child Loss Memorial Mass

On this day, we will offer a Memorial Mass at 7:00 pm in remembrance of all children who have died as a result of miscarriage, stillbirth, or early infant death. If you have lost a child during pregnancy or shortly after birth, you and your family members are invited to join us at this Mass. The loss may be recent or have occurred a long time ago.

As we remember these children and their families, we ask for the special intercession of St. Gianna Beretta Molla (feast day: April 28) and St. Catherine of Siena (feast day: April 29), patron saints of the unborn and those who have experienced the pain of loss during pregnancy.

Mass of Anointing of the Sick Tuesday, April 30 at 11:00 am

There will be three priests available to hear confessions before Mass from 10:00 am to 10:50 am. Both confessionals have handsets for the hard of hearing and an additional accessible confessional will be set up at the church's north-east doors.

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is celebrated with those who are seriously ill, preparing for surgery and the frail and elderly. This sacrament of healing is meant to heal the whole person - spiritually, physically, and mentally - while at the same time reassuring the person of God's love and mercy.

Parish Engagement Survey Update

Last Fall, parishioners 18 years and older were invited to complete a parish Member Engagement Survey. The survey was created especially for churches by Gallup, a leading survey organization. To help uncover the meaning behind these survey responses, OLS parishioners were invited to join Focus group sessions. At these sessions, each of the three groups discussed 2 select survey questions, what they indicate, and where we should focus efforts to become a stronger, more engaged parish.

Work is now underway by each group to develop a shortlist of actionable ideas; with next steps to be determined by September. Thank you to the focus group participants and all parishioners for lending your voice to this important initiative at OLS.


