At least 1,900 people are dead, 9,000 are injured and 30,000 are homeless after the recent earthquake. Then on Monday evening, Tropical Storm Grace caused floods and mudslides. Our Archdiocese has opened a humanitarian relief fund to assist; the country is unable to adequately respond to these natural disasters without international assistance.

Donations will be sent through Caritas Internationalis, who have a long history of disaster relief efforts and are already on the ground in Haiti. Our donations will be used for food, water, shelter, clothing and medical supplies.
