We are pleased to welcome Deacon Sarfaraz Pinto to Our Lady of Sorrows Parish, appointed by Archbishop Leo. In his



role as a Permanent Deacon, his ministry work at OLS will include: assisting in the ministry of the Word, the ministry of the altar, and the ministry of charity. He will share these responsibilities with Deacon Jeremy.

Deacon Sarfaraz recently moved to Etobicoke after having served at a Markham Parish for close to 14 years.
