

Advent Resources & Reflection

Second Week of **Advent Reflection**

In this second week of Advent. we light the candle of Peace. This is a time of coming together, of building a community of faith that is open to all, and of preparing the way.

The central themes in the readings this weekend challenge us to prepare our hearts for Jesus. Am I ready to change my ways? Am I ready to ask God for help?

In the Gospel, John calls us to straighten out whatever crooked paths we've been walking. If we have been pushing God off to the side of our road. If we have been saying we don't really have time for Him. If we need to overcome deep resentments, own up to dishonesty or have been unwilling to forgive someone. We are called to bring peace to our resentments and allow God to do his healing work in our lives.

Advent is a time of LONGING AND WAITING for the Lord to come. Premature decoration of the church building and early use of Christmas songs at liturgy compromise the spirit of expectation.



VIOLET VESTMENTS reflect longing and anticipation, not penance. Rose vestments may be used on the third (Gaudete) Sunday to signal the mid-point of the season.





ALLELUIA continues to be sung in the Gospel Acclamation and in other songs. This is the clearest indication that Advent is a season of expectation, not penance.
