SYNOD ON SYNODALITY

invited the

faithful to
celebrate a
vear

dedicated to the family and to deepen our understanding of his Apostolic Exhortation *Amoris Laetitia*, "The Joy of Love". The *Amoris Laetitia* Family Year will conclude with the 10th World Meeting of Families, which will take place in Rome and will also be celebrated in local dioceses, 22 – 26 June 2022.

"We are becoming increasingly aware of the laity's identity and mission in the Church and in society. You have the mission of transforming society by your presence in the workplace and ensuring that the needs of families are taken into due account."

The Office of Family and Life (CCCB) has created an **online resource**, through video, text and reflection questions to offer ways for us to learn, pray, and discern.

Pope Francis has launched the **Synod** on **Synodality**: a two-year global process of listening to the faithful.

"Synodality is the way of being the Church today according to the will of God, in a dynamic of discerning and listening together to the voice of the Holy Spirit." ~ Pope Francis

"By walking together, and together reflecting on the journey made, the Church will be able to learn from what it will experience which processes can help it to live communion, to achieve participation, to open itself to mission."

We are being given an opportunity to help shape how our Church will operate in today's world. The goal is to ensure the participation of the greatest number possible, in order to listen to the *living voice of the entire People of God*.

This is not possible unless we make special efforts to **actively reach out to people where they're at**, especially those who are often excluded or who are not involved in the life of the Church.

We are asking all of our parishioners to add their voice and thoughts to the Synod survey, found <u>here.</u>

We also are asking you to go one step farther and send the survey to your friends and family who may be occasional church goers or not currently participating in the life of the Church. The Pope wants to hear from **everyone**, and receive all perspectives, every voice counts.
