Once the church reaches capacity, we have additional seating in the parish hall. COVID protocols are in effect. The Archdiocese has provided updates on how the recent easing of restrictions will affect our parish. Major notes:

- Six-foot physical distancing for churches is still required. Our mass seating capacity will remain the same until physical distancing restrictions change.
- Masks must be worn at all times within the parish buildings
- Parish halls can reopen for nonsacramental use with a maximum capacity of 50 people, with physical distancing
- We can start singing as a congregation! Well-fitted masks must be worn while singing.
