Lenten Gift Card Drive

The OLS St Vincent de Paul Society provides services to our neighbours-in-need through home visitations and emergency assistance in the form of food vouchers, clothing, furniture, and help to access appropriate services. Through the generosity of you, our parishioners, they were able to provide assistance to 47 households including, 67 adults and 54 children, making 391 visits in 2021.

This pandemic has led to a large increase in requests for from assistance. our neighbours-in-need. St. Vincent de Paul is launching a Lenten Gift Card drive to support families with basic necessities. When you do your shopping, consider purchasing a grocery gift card and dropping it in the collection basket at any of the weekend Masses. They would like to request PC. Loblaws and **No-Frills** gift cards, in denominations of \$25, to provide those needing assistance with flexibility.

Tax receipts can be issued by St. Vincent de Paul for donations over \$25. To receive a receipt they will need the original purchase receipt, your full name and address. You can place the gift cards in the collection box or the parish office mail slot.
