Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fasting and Abstinence. Fasting (ages 18-59) either bread and water only OR one main meal and two smaller meals, with no solid foods in between. Abstinence: (ages 14+) no meat or another favorite food and moderation in all food and drink. In lieu of fasting, one may substitute works of charity.
