Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time



The readings for this Sunday help us think about our choices. God gives us the freedom to choose between good and evil. He doesn't force us. But He wants us to choose life. His commandments are there to guide us, not to burden us. In the Gospel, Jesus says He didn't come to get rid of the law. He came to bring it to its fullest meaning. He wants more than just the outside actions. He calls us to go deeper—to be honest, to be pure, to let go of anger, and to speak with truth.

We are invited to follow God with our whole heart. His commandments are not just rules. They are the way to love Him and others. They help us walk with Him every day.

Reflection Questions:

- How can I go beyond just following rules and truly live my faith?
- How does anger or hatred affect my relationships?
- What steps can I take to grow in love, wisdom, and truth?

SEASON OF LENT

Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of the liturgical season of Lent; 40 days of prayer, fasting, penance and reflection in preparation for Christ's Resurrection on Easter Sunday. **Ashes will be distributed on Feb. 18 at the 9:00 am and 7:30 pm Masses.**

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and of abstinence from meat. Fasting is a penitential discipline intended to open our hearts to God and others, a means of purification and spiritual liberation, and a witness of the depth of our faith. The law of "abstinence from meat" binds those who are 14 years and older, and the law of "fasting" binds those from 18 to 59 years of age. Fridays are days of abstinence from meat, but Catholics may substitute special acts of charity or piety on this day.



 **Have last year's blessed palms?** Return them to the parish office or place them at the back of the church to be used for Ash Wednesday ashes.
