The Presentation of the Lord



In the Gospel, Mary and Joseph took baby Jesus to the temple. They met Anna and Simeon, two holy people who recognized Jesus as the Son of God. Jesus is the Light of Revelation who will bring God's truth to everyone. Simeon foretold that a sword would pierce Mary's soul, a moment that earned her the title "Our Lady of Sorrows."

The Presentation is also a call to "present" our own lives to God. It means letting go of selfishness, sacrificing comfort, or simply placing our lives in His hands. Each small sacrifice is a way of saying "yes" to God, following Mary's example of complete trust and surrender.

Reflection questions:

- How can I show more obedience to God in my daily life?
- Are there any prayers I am waiting on God to answer?
- What sacrifices can I make to grow closer to God?


