Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time



In today's Gospel, Jesus calls us to show compassion and help each other. Instead of judging, we should try to understand the struggles others are facing, building stronger, more loving communities. We learn to follow the path that Jesus set for us by loving our enemies, despite our instincts urging us to hate.

We should live with mercy, choosing kindness over revenge, and forgiving those who have wronged us. Forgiveness is something we all need. Holding grudges can harm us and prevent us from finding peace. Jesus teaches that we must forgive to be forgiven.

Reflection questions:

- What does it mean to bear the image of Christ in my actions?
- How can I show love to my enemies in practical ways?
- Why is forgiveness important for my own peace and well-being?



Session on Palliative Care Tuesday, February 25


You are invited to attend the last session of Horizons of Hope, designed to help


