Be the Light

The readings for the 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time focus on evangelization – spreading the Light of Christ and service.



February 5, 2023

The first reading from Isaiah

tells us that being devoted to God means taking care of those who need our help the most. God wants us to care for those in need, and it is through these acts that the darkness in our lives will turn to light. We are called to do more than just pray for people. We are called to act. When we do this, the darkness of society will be overcome with light.

The second reading from 1st Corinthians reminds us that we do not rely on our own wisdom when we speak and act, but on God.

Matthew's gospel reading also uses the image of light. At the beginning of the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus compares his disciples to salt, light, and a city set on a hill. All these things exist not for themselves, but for something else. In the same way, Christians are meant to make the world a better place – we are called to affect the culture as salt, light, and a city on a hill.

Jesus also tells us that when salt loses its flavour, it is no longer salt. Similarly, if we are all talk, but we don't understand the message of Christ crucified, then we are missing a crucial characteristic of being Christians. Through our good works, others can encounter Christ through us.

Reflection Questions:

When I see darkness in the world, do I try to bring light? How have I been a light recently? Where does my light need to shine this week?
