FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

The readings for this week remind us that God is always waiting for us to return to Him so we can receive the abundance of life he offers us. The first reading tells of how the Israelites celebrated Passover on the plains of Jericho. In the second reading Paul tells us to be reconciled to God. In the gospel, Jesus tells the parable of the prodigal son, which is sometimes called the parable of the forgiving father.
