Second Sunday in Ordinary Time



The readings this weekend invite us to hear and respond to God's calling.

In the first reading, Samuel is a young boy who hears God's call and becomes a great prophet, even amidst the corruption and spiritual decline in his community. Samuel's readiness sets an example for us today to listen carefully and respond to God's personal messages.

In the Gospel, John the Baptist calls Jesus the "Lamb of God," and two other disciples start following Jesus. The disciples' decision to follow Jesus begins with curiosity and leads to a deeper understanding of His identity. We too are invited to grow and transform our relationship with Jesus.

Reflection Questions:

- Do I recognize Jesus at work in my life and am I enthusiastic in growing my relationship with Him?
- How can I be more attentive and listen to God's guidance amidst the noise of my busy life?
- What can I do to deepen my relationship with Jesus to grow from following to understanding to action?
