Call to Holiness

The Mass readings for the 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time inspire us to think about the call to holiness and the need to declare that Jesus has died for our redemption.

In the first reading, we hear one of the Servant's Songs. The psalm is a prayer that asks a common question: Here I am Lord, what is your will and plan for me? The second reading from 1st Corinthians evokes the call to holiness.

The Gospel recalls the public actions of John the Baptist to identify Jesus as the Son of God. John the Baptist witnesses the Spirit descending upon Jesus.

We don't always clearly see God's plan. God's invitation is a call to holiness in our everyday lives, for today's world.

Pope Francis describes holiness as the most attractive face of the Church, and he emphasizes that the Church's universal call to holiness is attainable, despite the challenges of everyday life:

"You don't need special education or qualifications, nor to have taken religious vows to be holy – just an open heart and a desire to spend some time with the Lord in Prayer and by reading the Gospel. The Church makes available everything you need to become holy."
