Third Sunday in Ordinary Time



Mark's Gospel introduces the beginning of Jesus' public ministry. Jesus proclaims the good news of God's kingdom, calling people to repentance and belief in the Gospel. The immediacy with which Simon, Andrew, James, and John respond to Jesus' call is striking. They leave their nets, their family, and their livelihoods to follow Him.

This invitation is extended to each of us today. For us, it might mean different sacrifices or changes – perhaps a change in lifestyle, priorities, or attitudes. The call to follow Jesus is both personal and transformative, demanding a response that is as immediate and decisive as that of the first disciples.

Reflection Questions:

- In what areas of my life is God calling me and how can I be more open to change?
- •How have I experienced God's mercy and forgiveness in my life, and in what ways can I extend that same mercy and forgiveness to others?
- •How can I be more responsive to God's call in my daily life, and what might be holding me back from fully embracing the Gospel message?

SUNDAY OF THE WORD OF GOD
