

Blessing of Candles — Saturday, Feb. 1

Next weekend is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. Candles will be blessed at the beginning of the 5:15 pm



Mass. The blessing of candles symbolizes Christ as the "Light of the World," as foretold by Simeon in the temple. It marks Jesus' presentation in the temple and fulfills the prophecy that He would bring light to both Jews and Gentiles. The blessing reminds us to carry and share Christ's light throughout the year, dispelling darkness and living in His truth.

Blessing of Throats — Monday, Feb. 3

On the feast of St. Blaise, we will offer the traditional blessing of throats after the 9:00 am Mass, seeking St. Blaise's intercession for protection from ailments of the throat

and other illnesses. St. Blaise, a 4th-century bishop and martyr, is known for his healing miracles, particularly for those suffering from throat diseases. This blessing reminds us of the power of faith, prayer, and the saints' intercession in our lives.

Mass with Contemporary Music 12:30 pm Mass on Sunday, Feb. 9


