The Epiphany marks the visit of the Magi to the infant Jesus, guided by a bright, shining star. This light is different from the power of

King Herod. Despite having kingly power himself. Herod reacts to the news with violence and orders male children to be killed. Jesus. though a baby, shows a different kind of kingship. He is humble and vulnerable, representing a different kind of authority marked by gentleness and love.

Although the Magi are wise and powerful, they bow down to the infant Jesus, recognizing the true value of humility. In God's kingdom, the humble are lifted up, and power is found in love and service. The Epiphany reminds us that Jesus came for all people, and His light shines on everyone.

Reflection Questions:

- How can I share the light of Jesus with those around me?
- How does Jesus' kingship challenge traditional views of power?
- What does the Feast of the Epiphany teach me about God's kingdom and my place in it?
