

INDIGENOUS RECONCILIATION

While our archdiocese did not operate residential schools, it has a responsibility to take genuine and meaningful steps to journey with Indigenous communities on the path to reconciliation, and to assist in healing the trauma experienced from the residential school system. To this end they are establishing working groups, enriched by Indigenous voices, to guide and support their efforts. The top priorities are:

Outreach & Spiritual support:

Initiatives to support survivors of residential schools and those suffering intergenerational trauma. These may include healing circles, personal or group counselling, workshops, speakers, listening sessions, opportunities for prayer, reconciliation services, and other spiritual supports.

Education:

Initiatives to educate on the tragic legacy of residential schools and its continuing impact on Indigenous people. To develop a greater understanding and appreciation of Indigenous spirituality.

Financial Support:

Our Archdiocese is developing a financial campaign to support ongoing healing and reconciliation efforts. In response to those who have expressed a desire to contribute immediately, the Healing and

Reconciliation fund has been established. Donations can be made online **here**, by phone (416) 934-3411 or through any Catholic church in the Archdiocese of Toronto.
