The Living Eucharist

Reconciliation

The readings for Corpus Christi this weekend focus on the Eucharist. We are reminded that God cared for the Israelites by providing manna. By receiving Holy Communion, we are spiritually fed and united in each other. And in the Gospel of John, we hear that through the Holy Eucharist Jesus takes up residence in us and we become the very presence of Christ in our world.

The messages we hear in the readings this weekend are still relevant for us today. We can become prideful and forgetful of God's blessings when we are comfortable, and things are going well. We can take our possessions or accomplishments for granted, or feel as though we have achieved success on our own merit.

The Gospel reading is a powerful reminder of the mystery and depth of Christ's love for us, and of the transformative power of the Eucharist. This belief in the true presence of Christ in the Eucharist is central to our Catholic faith. It is a living reminder of the depth of His love for us. When we receive the Eucharist, we are not just partaking in a symbolic act - we are truly receiving the body and blood of Christ, which sustains us and empowers us to live out our faith in the world.

Reflection Questions:


- Do I recognize the depth of Christ's love for me in my daily life?
