# **Covid Protocols**

As we reopen, we want to refresh you on how we are keeping our parishioners safe with our COVID Protocols as welcome you back to the church:

- Everyone will enter through one of the Cliveden doors (north or south) depending on the service
- Contact information will be collected for exposure tracing.
- Masks are mandatory for your entire time in the church.
- Masks need to cover your nose, mouth and chin.
- Parishioners will be asked to line up **outside** until a spot is available – with distancing.
