Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)



In today's Gospel, Jesus gave his disciples certain instructions for where and how they should go about their preparations for the Passover. Likewise, Christ invites us to prepare well for Holy Mass. For a wedding or special celebration, a lot of planning and preparation are involved in making sure that the food, venue, guests, and everyone or everything else are ready for that special occasion. That is why at Church, we have a welcoming hospitality, beautiful music, congregational singing, good preaching, and the Eucharist at the centre of our liturgical worship. All of these elements are significant for how we approach Mass, yet they are always meant to lead our focus on what is happening at Mass. Most importantly, every Mass is a representation of His Sacrifice at Calvary (Catechism #1367). In a mystical way, that moment where Jesus offered up His Body and Blood on the Cross is presented to us in the way He gave it to His disciples at the Last Supper. When we take five to ten minutes to quiet our hearts before Mass, we can allow Jesus to prepare our hearts like the disciples. By keeping our focus on who we are encountering at Mass, we will be more than ready to meet our Lord with joy and anticipation like His disciples at the Last Supper.



The month of <u>June is dedicated to our devotion the Sacred Heart of Jesus</u>. We celebrate the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on June 7. This devotion is one of the most widely practiced and well-known Catholic devotions in the Archdiocese of Toronto and for Catholics worldwide.
