Many of us have heard and been discussing the unmarked gravesite found at the former residential school in Kamloops, BC, containing the remains of missing indigenous children. This discovery has reopened a painful wound for many and reinforces the need for all of us to learn more about our history, residential schools and to seek the truth for all those who suffered and continue to do so.

The abuse of Indigenous peoples is a dark chapter in our country and Church. While the Church has cared for and served Indigenous people in many ways, it is undeniable that some members of the Church undermined the dignity of First Nations people. There is evidence that much of this abuse occurred at residential schools, which were largely operated by Christian denominations. A statement from our Cardinal and resources can be found here.
