## **Opening our Eyes**

The Gospel for the 4th Sunday of Lent is the story of the man born blind, whom Jesus cured.

Jesus uses ordinary saliva and dirt to heal the blind man with a simple gesture, showing his divine power and ability to transform and sanctify all things.



In Jewish culture, it was believed that physical disabilities were the result of sin, either of the individual or their parents. However, Jesus challenges this view by stating that the man's blindness was not caused by sin, and he uses this opportunity to display God's power.

Like the woman at the well in last Sunday's Gospel, the blind man is also an outcast in society. In both cases, an encounter with Jesus brings about a significant change and transformation in the person's life. For the woman at the well, she becomes a believer and a witness to her community, while the man born blind receives physical healing and spiritual insight.

#### Reflection Questions:

- How has Jesus provided healing in my life?
- Am I open to receiving Jesus' personal encounter and transformation?
- In what ways am I spiritually blind?


# **PARISH NEWS & EVENTS**

RCIA Second Scrutiny is celebrated this Sunday at the 9:30am Mass.

The Scrutinies are Rites celebrated on the Third, Fourth and Fifth Sundays of Lent by the "Elect" - those who are preparing to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Communion at Easter. The scrutinies are rites for self-searching and repentance. They are meant to uncover and heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the Elect and to bring out and strengthen all that is upright, strong and good.

This weekend, the Gospel tells the story of the healing of the man born blind. When the man worships Jesus, he receives spiritual as well as physical sight.

Through this Scrutiny, the Elect are called to be enlightened – to have patterns of sin and blindness revealed and to grow in God's truth. Jesus says, "I am the light of the world". His words call us to Him today and they also foreshadow the enlightenment and Sacraments to be celebrated at Easter.

- Saturday afternoon from 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm


