

Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time



In today's Gospel, Jesus tells us to look at our own faults before judging others, practicing true humility to grow closer to God. We often judge people based on their appearance, wealth, or status.

What really matters is the condition of their hearts. As good trees bear good fruit, if our hearts are good, we will naturally do and say good things. When we speak with love and humility, we build each other up. Things like pride blind us to our own faults, turning us into hypocrites. Our pride is a barrier to holiness and prevents us from leading others to Christ. We are called to reflect on our own sins and grow in humility.

Reflection questions:

- How do my actions and words show my faith?
- How can I strengthen my relationships with others?
- What actions can I take to grow in humility?



"I urge you, first of all, to pray for all people. Ask God to help them; intercede on their behalf, and give thanks for them." - 1 Timothy 2:1

Intercession is a prayer of petition which leads us to pray as Jesus did. We are encouraged to make intercessory prayer a priority, seeking God's help for others and expressing gratitude for their presence in our lives.
