Sacrament of Marriage - Parishioners must be registered and regularly attending Mass. Please contact us one year prior to your requested wedding date.




We welcome those who joined the Catholic church and celebrated the sacraments of initiation at the Easter Vigil:

Liturgical Bites: Easter Peace! - The first greeting of the Risen Christ to His bewildered apostles was, *"Peace be with you."* They were living in fear of their external enemies, the Jews and the Romans; and they were also feeling the internal guilt of betraying and abandoning Jesus. So, they were overjoyed when Jesus reiterated the gift of peace a second time.

Jesus knew that peace was what they most needed then, and what is most needed in our troubled and divided world today. By His death and resurrection, Jesus shows us that love is stronger than hatred, life stronger than death.

God forgives us without conditions. For Easter peace to be ours, we are called to let go of our hurts and anger. Reconciliation with God and with each other is the key to peace in our hearts and peace in the world.

Pope Francis often speaks about the importance of creating this inner peace in our lives:

"Every human being desires communion and peace. Everyone needs peaceful co-existence. But this can grow only when we also build inner peace in our heart. Many people live in a constant hurry. In this way all that they have inside them tends to be overwhelmed.

This also affects how we treat the environment. It is necessary to grant oneself more time to recover a serene harmony with the world, creation, and the Creator."

Let us try, in contemplation and prayer, to achieve ever greater familiarity with God. And gradually we will discover that the heavenly Father wants what is good for us. He wants to see us happy, full of joy and serene."
