

Lent is a season of reflection, penance, and renewal, inviting us to deepen our relationship with God through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. It's a time to prepare our hearts for the Paschal mystery, as we walk with Jesus in His journey toward the cross.

In the Gospel, Jesus faces three temptations in the desert, each testing His commitment to His mission and His trust in God. We face similar challenges in our lives. We must rely on God in times of trial to stay focused on what's important. We turn to Him in prayer and believe that He will guide us on the right path.

Reflection questions:

- What steps can I take to deepen my faith during Lent?
- What temptations do I face that challenge my faith?
- In what ways can I trust God more in difficult situations?
