THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

In today's gospel, Jesus calls Peter and the disciples beyond the teacher -student relationship. Up to this point, he has been their rabbi or "great one" and they have been his followers. They followed him, as a Jewish disciple would follow a rabbi. He gave them instruction and an example to follow.

Sometimes our own journeys follow this pattern. We might start out with some knowledge of Jesus. Then have perhaps we deeper a understanding. We might have an experience which sends us into a infatuation period of and excitement. But eventually we come to that deep love, like the love between spouses, with its lasting commitment.

Reflections:

- When Jesus asks me "Do you love me?", what is my honest answer?
- How do I love Jesus?
- Do I see myself as a friend of Christ?
