Ascension of the Lord



The Feast of the Ascension commemorates the day Jesus ascended into heaven after His resurrection. The Gospel reading from Mark tells us about Jesus' last instructions to His disciples: He tells them to go out and share the Gospel everywhere.

The disciples did as Jesus commanded and although Jesus ascended into heaven. He continues to be active in the world through His followers. Jesus' appeal was not just to the disciples – it is also a clear message for us today to continue Jesus' work. He guides us through the Holy Spirit to use our gifts to spread the message of his Gospel through our faith and our actions.


