Sharing Jesus' Message

The feast of the Ascension of the Lord commemorates the day that Jesus Christ ascended into heaven. He also gave the Great Commission: that all the world should be Saved. In the first reading, the ascension of Jesus is recounted, and the Apostles are told they will receive the Holy Spirit. In the second reading, we hear that Jesus rules heaven and earth. And in the Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples to preach the Good News to the whole world.

The Ascension of Jesus is a significant event in the Christian faith. As He ascended into heaven, his disciples watched in awe, wondering what would come next. Jesus left them with a command to be his witnesses, and to spread the message of salvation and being "disciple makers". This command was not only for Jesus' first disciples but for all believers throughout history, including us today.

The Holy Spirit plays a central role in our faith, empowering and guiding us. Jesus promised to send the Holy Spirit to his disciples, and he continues to guide and empower us today. The Holy Spirit gives us the strength, wisdom and gifts we need to serve others, proclaim the gospel message, and work for justice and peace.

- How do I welcome the Great Commission to be a witness of Christ?
- When have I experienced the power of the Holy Spirit in my life?
- How can I share the message of the love of Christ in my interactions with others?

Pentecost Sunday



Pentecost will be celebrated next Sunday, May 28. The word has its roots in the Greek word "pentecoste" which means "50th day" and accordingly occurs 50 days after the

death and resurrection of Jesus, and ten days after his ascension.

Pentecost concludes the Easter season and celebrates the beginning of the Church. It is the celebration of the Holy Spirit coming upon the Apostles, Mary and the first followers of Jesus. The Holy Spirit gave the apostles the gifts necessary to fulfill The Great Commission – to go out and preach the Gospel to all nations – and calls on each of us to continue to spread His message.

Confirmation - Next week, May 23 to 25, Bishop Ivan Camilleri will celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation with 80 of our young adult parishioners.

We would like to thank all the parents and catechists who prepared the confirmandis to celebrate this special moment of receiving the gifts of the Holy Spirit which will strengthen them as they continue their faith journey.

57th World Day of Social Communications - Sunday, May 21

Today is the World Day of Social Communications, observed by the Vatican and Dioceses around the world. Pope Francis has released a communication on the theme "Speaking with the heart: *Vertatem facientes in caritate* (The truth in love).

Pope Francis calls on all Catholics to develop a cordial way of communication, for words capable of doing good for others and of touching even the "most hardened of hearts".

In a world that is "so inclined towards indifference and indignation, at time even on the basis of disinformation which falsifies and exploits the truth", Pope Francis emphasizes that it is important to create space for proclaiming the truth "even if at times uncomfortable."

Pope Francis prays that Jesus might "help us to make our communication clear open and heartfelt" and "help us speak the truth in charity, so that we may feel like protectors of one another."
