The readings for this Sunday illustrate how love is at the core of our Christian life. In the Gospel, Jesus explains what it means to remain in His love: to keep His commandments. Jesus associates love with joy. By commanding us to love one another, He is inviting us to live a life of true joy.

As followers of Christ, we are called to live out the love of God in a real and tangible way, showing love to everyone we meet without partiality. When we love genuinely, we make the truth that "God is love" visible and active. Through His words and example, Jesus has equipped us to bring this divine love into the world. He has also given us the gift of the Holy Spirit to help us deliver the light of Christ to every corner of our lives and beyond.

- How can I be more impartial and show God's love to those who are different from me?
- What are some practical steps that I can take to follow Jesus' command to love one another?
- How can I be more open to the guidance of the Holy Spirit in my daily life?


