

Walking with Jesus

The readings for the 5th Sunday of Easter remind us that we are called to follow Jesus and serve him, even though we don't know where that might lead. The first reading describes how and why the first deacons were chosen. second reading reminds us of our precious identity as God's Chosen People, beloved sons and daughters of God. And in the Gospel, Jesus asks us to have faith in him.



The Gospel offers us comfort, guidance, and encouragement: "Do not let vour hearts be troubled. Believe in God. believe also in me." Jesus describes himself as "the way, the truth, and the life." These words, his life and his teachings demonstrate how He is the way to healing and wholeness.

Jesus also calls us to make the world a better place for all by caring for those in need, working together as a community and seeking to do the will of God in all that we do.

Reflection Questions:

- How can I follow the path that Jesus has laid out for me?
- Do I have faith that Jesus walks with me on my journey, ready to carry me during difficult times?
- What are some practical ways in my everyday life that I can continue Jesus' work in the world?
