What does remembrance mean to you?
The Church recognizes the month of November as a time to remember departed souls in our prayer intentions and pray for

those who, as the priest prays during the Liturgy of the Eucharist, "have gone before us with the sign of faith." Pope Francis said on All Souls' Day, that the day brought to mind "the people who went before us", both "those who did good" and "those who did not do so much good, but ... were received in God's mercy." At the same time, he suggested, the Commemoration recalled "hope, which is memory looking forward." Lastly, we also need to pray for peace "so that people will no longer kill each other in wars."

What is the prayer for all souls for the month of November? Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May their souls and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.
