Synod Synthesis Report The Synod Synthesis report has been completed and is now available in English. The report summarizes discussions at the assembly of the Synod of Bishops in Rome. Among the topics addressed in the report were clerical sexual abuse, women's roles in the church, outreach to poor and the concept of "synodality" itself. The assembly included 364 voting members — 365 counting Pope Francis. In addition to the Bishops, 21% of participants were lay women, lay men, religious and priests. The assembly's discussions set the stage for a year-long period of reflection that will culminate in the second and final synod assembly in late 2024. Visit https://bit.ly/40vjKQ3
