Pope Francis' Message for the 2023 World Day of the Poor. On the occasion of the World Day of the Poor on Sunday, Nov. 19, Pope Francis has released an important message and reflection: "Do not turn your face away from anyone who is poor" (Tobias, 4:7). In these times that are not particularly sensitive to the needs of the poor, every Christian is asked not to take the easy road of delegating charity to others, but rather to get personally involved. Pope Francis reminds us: "...when we encounter a poor person, we cannot look away, for that would prevent us from encountering the face of Jesus."

He also asks us to carefully consider the words: "from anyone who is poor". He reminds us that everyone is our neighbour -- regardless of the colour of their skin, their social standing, or where they were born. "The Book of Tobit teaches us to be realistic and practical in whatever we do with and for the poor. This is a matter of justice. It requires us to seek out and find one another, in order to foster the harmony needed for the community to feel itself as such. Caring for the poor is more than simply a matter of a hasty hand-out. It calls for re-establishing the just interpersonal relationships that poverty harms. In this way, "not turning our face away from anyone who is poor" leads us to enjoy the benefits of mercy and charity that give meaning and value to our entire Christian life.
