
October: Month of Mary and the Rosary




We invite you to join us for communal prayer of the rosary every weekday at 8:25am prior the 9:00am Mass at OLS. At home, we encourage families to:

## **Church Maintenance Update**

Over the summer months, there have been several repair & maintenance projects undertaken in the church & property:

- Completion of flooring refurbishment in the Sanctuary, Sacristy and Ministry Room (\$10,390)
- Bell Tower repairs and consulting fees (\$9,600)
- Electrical repairs to the nave switches (\$7,370)
- Painting of window frames, fascia/eaves, front entrance of Rectory/Parish Office and caulking of windows and entryways (\$8,710)
- Pruning of trees on church grounds (\$3,155)
- Bathroom repairs and kitchen faucet replacements in parish hall (\$2,860)
- Quarterly elevator maintenance and Alarm System Monitoring (\$2,950)
- Replacement of sprinkler heads to driplines to save on water consumption (\$2,600)
