Parishioners must be registered and regularly attending Mass. Please contact us one year prior to your requested wedding date.


Pastoral References

October 29 at the 9:30 am Mass, we will celebrate the Baptisms of Johan, Sam, Siena and Sofia. Please pray for these children and their families.


Second Collection this weekend: World Mission Sunday
