ENCOUNTER, REPENT, LOVE

The readings for the 31st Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C focus on conversion and repentance. In the first reading we are told that God wants us to repent. In the second reading, Paul speaks of the day of the Lord. In the Gospel, Zacchaeus dines with Jesus and repents.

By the example of Zacchaeus, Jesus takes a person who is hated by society — a tax collector — and shows how nobody is beyond transformation and salvation. We all have a deep down hunger for God and desire to see Jesus. When we follow those promptings, wonderful things can happen.

Reflection Questions:

* Do my encounters with Jesus change me?

* How am I called to repent?

* What can I do to be more welcoming to those who are on the outside?

Jesus shows us that transformation starts with love. Once the outsider knows he is loved, he can let go of his sins and freely follow Jesus. Like Jesus, we should not be afraid to encounter others and tell them the Good News that they are loved.

FEAST OF ALL SOULS


Wednesday, November 2


