# **RUNNING ROOM ROOF** REPLACEMENT Begins Sept. 21st

The commercial building on our parish property (currently leased to the Running Room and Desjardin Insurance) has had a number of roof leaks during the past few years which have been difficult to repair as there are two layers of roofing on the building. Starting this week, the old roofing will be removed and a new roof will be installed. Revenue from the leases will cover this cost, however this means those funds will not be available to fund parish operations.

Parking: The roofing company 's equipment will take up approximately 8 parking spots for the duration of the work. If there are rain delays this week, this will affect parking for Stewardship Sunday next weekend. Those who can walk to Mass next weekend or are able to park elsewhere, are encouraged to leave the parking lot spaces for those with less mobility.
