Do we use our gifts and talents to grow the Kingdom of God?

The readings for the 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C ask if we are as energetic in our spiritual lives as we are in acquiring wealth and the respect of others.

- In the first reading we are warned against cheating others and trampling on their rights.
- The psalm reminds us that God cares about the poor.
- In the second reading Paul reminds us to pray for everyone, including those in authority.
- In the gospel Jesus tells the parable of the Dishonest Steward, who used his wits to gain favor.

Reflection Questions:

- Do I have a healthy relationship with possessions and money?
- Is there something I feel is owed to me which I can let go of?
- Am I able to receive the generosity of others with grace?

RUNNING ROOM ROOF REPLACEMENT

Begins @ Sept. 21st

The commercial building on our parish property (currently leased to the Running Room and Desjardin Insurance) has had a number of roof leaks during the past few years which have been difficult to repair as there are two layers of roofing on the building.

Starting this week, the old roofing will be removed and a new roof will be installed. Revenue from the leases will cover this cost, however this means those funds will not be available to fund parish operations.

Parking: The roofing company 's equipment will take up approximately 8 parking spots for the duration of the work.
