

PILGRIMAGE TO MEDJUGORJE, CROATIA, AUSTRIA, HUNGARY, CZECH REP. & POLAND

Sept 16 – 30, 2025 - 15 days - \$4990.00 (Toronto Dep. incl. all taxes & tips)

- Sept 16 Afternoon departure from Toronto via Warsaw to Split.
- Sept 17 Afternoon arrival in Split. Transfer by bus to Medjugorje, time for rest. Mass, dinner and overnight. **Hotel Pansion No-1**
- Sept 18 Full day in Medjugorje. Time to visit Apparition Mountain, the Stations of the Cross and pray at "Blue Cross", a place of great healings and graces. Mass, time for individual prayer, dinner and overnight.
- Sept 19 This morning we travel to Zagreb, the capital city of Croatia. Upon arrival our tour of Zagreb takes us to the thousand-year old Gornji grad (Upper Town) with the Presidential Palace, the iconic St Mark's Church, the Croatian parliament (Sabor) and the 19th century Dolnji grad (Lower Town). Dinner and overnight. **Hotel Double Tree by Hilton**
- Sept 20 After breakfast we travel to Budapest, the capital of Hungary. En route we visit a magnificent monastery in Tihany on Balaton Lake. Upon arrival in Budapest, evening dinner cruise on the river Danube and overnight. **NH Budapest city**
- Sept 21 Morning tour of Budapest includes views of the 13th century St. Matthias Church, the Citadel on Mt. Gellert, the Royal Castle, the Parliament, Hero's Square and the St. Stephen Basilica. After lunch, continue to Vienna for dinner and overnight. **Ananas Hotel**
- Sept 22 Today visit Vienna, the capital of Austria. Our tour takes us the Opera House, Hofburg Palace (outside), Belvedere Palace (outside) and its formal gardens. Then stroll the Garden, the pedestrian shopping street leading to St. Stephen's Cathedral and the Schonbrunn Palace. Mass and Dinner. In the evening an optional concert. Overnight.
- Sept 23 Morning departure to Prague, the capital city of Czech Republic, the "Golden City". En route we visit Melk Abbey, a Benedictine Abbey above the town of Melk, Mass. Continue to Prague for dinner and overnight. **Hotel Royal Prague**
- Sept 24 Full day in beautiful Prague. We visit the Church of Our Lady of Victory and see the renowned statue of the Infant Jesus of Prague, where we celebrate Mass. We visit the Old Town by the way of Golden Lane and then go to the Lesser Town to see the medieval Charles Bridge. We also see St. Nikolas Church, the Astronomic Clock and the Castle District where we tour St. Vitus Cathedral, St. George's Basilica and Wenceslas Square. Some free time in the afternoon for shopping and rest. Dinner and overnight in Prague.
- Sept 25 This morning we travel to Krakow in Poland. En route we stop in Wadowice, where we celebrate Mass, the birthplace of Pope St. John Paul II. Continue to Krakow for dinner and overnight. **Novotel Krakow City West**
- Sept 26 Morning visit of Lagiewniki – world known as "Divine Mercy Shrine". This is where St. Faustyna had had numerous visions of Christ, who told her to keep a diary of their encounters, during which he spoke to her of the Divine Mercy. We visit the convent of St. Faustyna, her tomb and relics and have Mass. In the afternoon, we visit the world-famous salt mines in Wieliczka.
- Sept 27 After breakfast we explore Krakow's Old Town. We visit the Market Square where we hear the silver trumpet of the bugler from the tower of St. Mary's Church. Many of the buildings in the Old Town are over 700 years old and include marvels such as the Town Hall Tower, the Cloth Hall and most of all the Wawel Royal Castle. Afternoon we travel to Auschwitz, the notorious Nazi concentration camp. We visit a cell in which St. Maximilian Kolbe died and also the Martyrdom Museum recalling the horrors of the Holocaust. Mass will be celebrated in one of Krakow's Churches. Return to Krakow for dinner and overnight.
- Sept 28 This morning, we visit Czestochowa – the site of Poland's greatest shrine – Our Lady of Czestochowa, also known as the "Black Madonna", a pilgrimage destination that goes back to the 14th century. We venerate the priceless and miraculous icon and have Mass. Then, continue to Warsaw for dinner and overnight.
- Sept 29 Morning panoramic tour of Warsaw Old city, restored after World War II. The Cathedral and Church of St John and Church of Stanislaus with Tomb of blessed Father Popieluszko – a priest murdered by communists during the 1989 uprising. Mass. Some free time for last minute shopping, then Farewell dinner and overnight. **Novotel Centrum**
- Sept 30 Morning transfer to the airport for a flight to Toronto. Afternoon arrival.

BALANCE OF PAYMENT:

Final balance due is payable 60 days prior to departure. For late bookings (within 60 days) full payment is due immediately.

CANCELLATION:

If cancellation is necessary, please advise IHT immediately in writing. Cancellation charges are as follows:

- 60 days before departure or earlier - \$300.00 per person
- between 60 and 30 days before departure – 50% of the total cost
- 30 days or less – 100% of the total cost

IF YOU CHANGE YOUR BOOKING:

A \$150.00 administration charge will be applied for changes you make to your booking outside the 60 days to departure period. Please note that name changes are not allowed and such will be treated as cancellations.

IF IHT CHANGES YOUR BOOKING:

IHT will advise you of any change we feel significantly alters the holiday which you have purchased from us. Occasionally, changes might occur close to departure time. In such cases, you will be notified as soon as possible. Due to circumstances beyond our control, the local tour operator may have to make last minute changes in hotel or schedule. We reserve the right to substitute any of the hotels with hotels in similar or better category. First class twin-bedded rooms with private facilities are used.

UNUSED SERVICES:

No refund or adjustment can be made for any portion of holiday not used.
